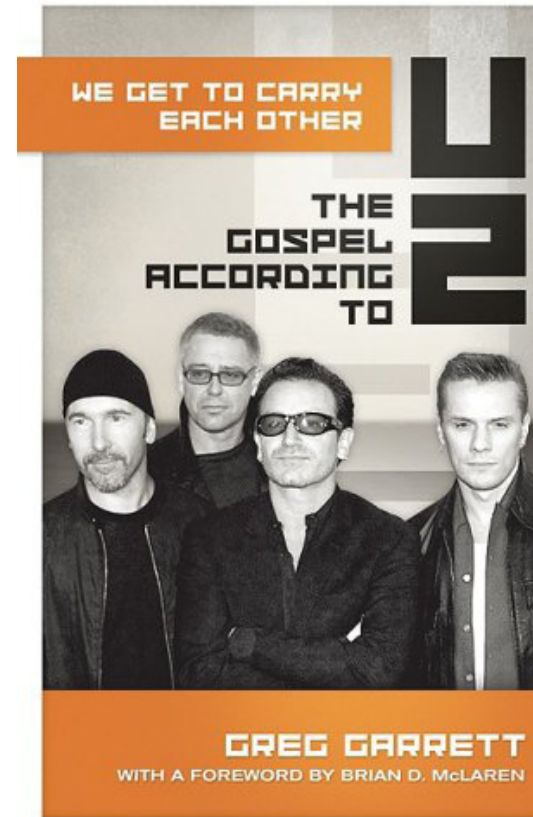

We Get to Carry Each Other: The Gospel According to U2



Beginning on the First Sunday of Advent, November 29, Good Shepherd will again welcome Dr. Greg Garrett to our Christian Education hour at 6:30p Sundays, following our regular Koinonia worship at 5:00p, and our Community Supper at 6:00p. Greg will discuss his recent book *We Get to Carry Each Other: The Gospel According to U2*.

Speaking to U2's music and sacramental theology, Greg will teach how the group's music illustrates Christian belief, provides a compelling example of faithful community, and how Bono and the band teach us about the importance of justice. Participants need not have read the book (or know anything about U2); Greg will show up with guitar in hand to introduce us to their lives and work.

Most of us know **Betty Hendrix** as the tireless chair of the Good Shepherd Prayer Shawl Ministry. But on August 23, she received a pin recognizing her 65 years as a volunteer with the American Red Cross of Central Texas.

Betty says she began volunteering at age 16, following in her mother's footsteps. During her time as a volunteer, she has taught classes ranging from swimming and lifeguard training to international humanitarian law. Betty rolled bandages for use in World War II, and, in the years since, has served in disaster assignments such as hurricanes, tornadoes and floods.

Betty reminds us that "the Red Cross meets immediate disaster-caused needs on a 24/7 basis. It's a great place to volunteer."

Public restrooms are available in the Administration building and the East Parish Hall (see map below).

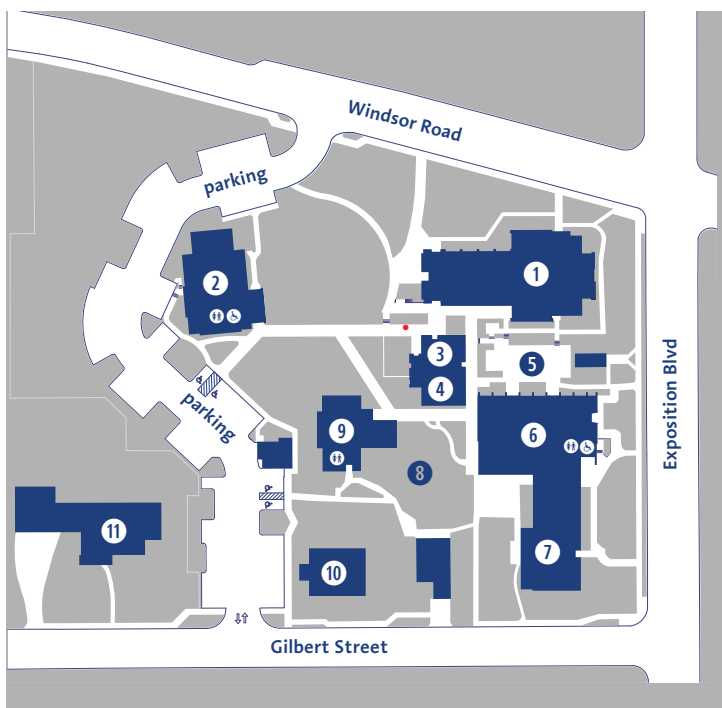
Parking
