THE GOSPEL Mark 8:31-38

- *Gospeller* The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Mark. *People* Glory to you, Lord Christ.
- *Gospeller* Jesus began to teach his disciples that the Son of Man must undergo great suffering, and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again. The Nicene Creed

Officiant We believe in one God,
